

Chapter 9: Raaj Vidya Raaj Guhya Yoga – Yoga of Sovereign Knowledge and Sovereign Mystery

This chapter is known as *Rajvidya Rajguhya yoga* or Yoga of Sovereign Knowledge and Sovereign mystery. *Rajvidya* means the most superior knowledge. *Rajguhya* means the most secretive knowledge. This knowledge is for those devotees who do not have any flaws in them. It is not for those devotees who act in a smart way. This knowledge is of a very high level and is considered to be the best.

This knowledge gives instant results and does not make you wait forever. This knowledge is for the saints not for sinners. This knowledge is very easy and can never be destroyed. Only the person with full faith can gain and utilize it.

Raj Vidya is for *Raja* (king). It is not for fools. The word *Raja* implies, father whose sons are *praja* (subjects). The husband is the *Raja* while the wife is the *praja*. The master of the house is the *Raja* while his servant is the *praja*. Rashtrapati is *Raja* then all the people are *praja*. In this body, the soul is the *Raja* while the body and organs are the *praja*. Of the senses the Mind is the *Raja* and other senses are *praja*. In the same way the ruler of this world the Supersoul is the *Raja* and all the rest are *praja*. The Lord takes care of us, as we are His children. The qualities He has as a father are described in this chapter. These should be emulated by an individual as a father, as a husband and as a master of the house.
