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Goals and Targets of the Youth for 2014

- ✚ Host a 'Bhagavad Geeta and Mahabarata Championship' competition.
- ✚ Revive the youth and children segment for the annual Holi celebrations.
- ✚ Stage annual Janmashtmi children and teenager plays.
- ✚ Host a *gotong-royong* to tidy up the second floor of the ashram. (preferably before the 'Bhagavad Geeta and Mahabarata Championship' competition.)
- ✚ Run the weekly Sunday satsang at least once in two months. (Youth Speaker, Bhajans etc)
- ✚ Raise RM 10,000 by December 2014 for the Geeta Ashram building fund through various fundraising activities and projects.
- ✚ Organize a futsal tournament as a fundraising initiative.
- ✚ Organize community service activities involving the youth.
- ✚ Update (ideally twice a week) and beautify the youth blog site on a regular basis.
- ✚ Gain a large following on the youth blog site. (Target: 500 followers)
- ✚ Form a structured and organized youth community.
